USING THE PRAYER DIARY

You will need to have your favourite Bible handy as every weekday has a Bible reference for inspiration and reflection. Each of the 40 days of Lent also contain a prayer for the day. Many of these prayers were written by Christians from the past and are from a collection by Rev. David Adam, former Vicar of Lindisfarne, who wrote some of the prayers in the collection. The prayers for each week follow a theme which is highlighted in capitals. On Sundays, which are not counted in the 40 days of Lent, use one of the Collects for that day.

Read each of the bible verses and the prayer slowly and prayerfully more than once, reflecting on the words and the sentiments expressed. Does anything resonate with you in your life as a witnessing disciple of Jesus, or in preparation for Holy Week? **Make these prayers your prayers**.

"Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me." Ps. 51:10-12

Life in all its fullness!

Alongside this devotional prayer diary, there is a booklet with ideas of activities you could do during the six weeks of Lent. It is available in church or on the website. These are set out in eight different sections: Spirituality, Environment, Church Community, Neighbours, Personal, Social Mission
