Pray for all the charity shops operating in Cannock. Pray for all their volunteers trying to do what they can to raise funds to enable the various charities to continue to help those in need. Give thanks for those who donate goods to be sold in the shops.

Sunday 4th

Father You are our rock, and we run to you today, believing that you will lift us up, that you will fuel us for the tasks you've given us, and that your joy will consume the weakness of our lives and make us strong again.

Pray for the hospices in our area providing end of life care not only for the patient but also for their families and loved ones who suffer with them. Pray for the doctors, nurses and carers who work in the hospices. Pray for anyone you know who is in a hospice at present.

Monday 19th

Pray for the work of Release International a UK-based Christian ministry, supporting believers around the world who are persecuted for Christ and the gospel. Release International prayerfully, pastorally and practically does all it can to love, serve and support persecuted and imprisoned Christians.

Tuesday 20th

Pray for Pastor Kim Kuk-Gi in North Korea charged with: Espionage and spreading 'religious propaganda' from an 'underground church. He was arrested in 2014 and was sentenced to life imprisonment with hard labour. He had dedicated much of his ministry to helping North Korean defectors in China.

Wednesday 21st

Pray for Mussie Ezaz has been an evangelist in Eritrea for more than 14 years and had worked with Youth for Christ for a number of years before developing his own ministry to young people as a leader in the Kale Hiwot Church. He was arrested by the authorities in 2007 but like many arrested Christians he has never been tried or charged.

Thursday 22nd

Pray for Ju Dianhong an ordinary Christian, who was arrested in China's southern Yunnan Province following an area-wide crackdown on cult activity. She was sentenced to 13 years imprisonment in 2016, falsely accused of leading the "Three Grades of Servants" religious sect for which police claimed she recruited members, did missionary work, and spread news of the apocalypse.

Friday 23rd

Pray today for the churchwardens at St. Luke's and St. Thomas . Give thanks for their hard work much of which goes on behind the scenes. We give thanks for all those who support and assist the wardens. Pray also for Theresa our verger and those who assist her.

Saturday 24th

Pray for the Ministry Team, for Vicky and Marie, for Gill, David and Di leading the worship week by week. Pray for those preparing to lead worship tomorrow. Pray for them as they prepare to preach God's word at tomorrow's worship services.

Sunday 25th

"Speak, O Lord, as we come to You To receive the food of Your Holy Word. Take Your truth, plant it deep in us; Shape and fashion us in Your likeness, That the light of Christ might be seen today In our acts of love and our deeds of faith.
